c – Speed Advisory sign – the new sign will be posted in different areas within the village, as a “Traffic Calmer”, its abilities to monitor vehicle speeds and provide images of vehicle type, color and license plate information will be used area deemed necessary by the department.

d- Crime Report – an increased amount of residential car burglaries have been reported within the village, which prompts the department to remind residents to keep your doors locked, remove all personal items in view and keep outside areas lit whenever possible.

e- Evaluations – The mid-year performance evaluations are being reviewed now for commanders and officers. This will provide clear communication to each officer on attainment of their yearly goals.
