RE: Water Main Improvement Project

Dear Lindenhurst Resident:

The Lake Michigan Water Main Improvement Project began last fall with work completed in Phase 1 – Contract 1. Phase 1 – Contract 2 is ready to begin with an early start date of February 9th, 2016. The Contractor, at present time, will begin to move equipment and materials into the staging areas and begin excavation immediately after. This undoubtedly will cause some delays for the residents within the construction area.

Work is scheduled to begin on Old Elm Road just east of Lindenhurst Drive. Having discussed this early start in the construction season, we have put into place some additional safe guards with the contractor in aiding with snow removal along the construction route. Additionally; if a portion of your driveway is removed, prior to their daily departure, all driveways are to be rechecked for settlement and addressed immediately to resolve these issues.

The streets directly impacted by the construction involved with the project are:

Old Elm Road	200 feet east of Lindenhurst Drive to Valley Drive
Lindenhurst Drive	All
Woodlane Drive	All
Valley Drive	From Old Elm Road to Sand Lake Road
Sand Lake Road	From Valley Drive to Grand Avenue
High Point Drive	From Beck Road to Northgate Road

Please be aware that not all of the various stages of construction can occur simultaneously, thus, it is likely that there will be periods of time during which no work is being done on your street. While the project may appear to be at a standstill, when in reality the contractor is working on another street elsewhere on the project site.

As you may imagine, several factors may affect the project completion date, such as inclement weather. In addition, projects such as these have the potential to create inconveniences such as noise, dust, mud, traffic delays, and an occasional missed mail delivery or garbage pick-up. Please be assured that we will strive to minimize the inconveniences, and we respectfully request your patience and understanding.
