Commissioner Berger reported that our new recommendation for Police Officer, Maloree Johnson was sworn in on September 11, 2017. She is currently attending the Suburban Law Enforcement Academy, S.L.E.A. located in Glen Ellyn. After graduating from the police academy, Officer Johnson will return to the Department and begin a 12-week Police Training Officer program with a certified PTO.

Chief Jones reported that the recent Village Golf Outing was well received, raising money for two charities; The Lake Villa Food Pantry and the 100 Club of Chicago, which assists families of fallen first responders in Lake County.

At the request of the Commissioner Douglas, Chief Jones will arrange a tour of the Police Academy, S.L.E.A. for the Commissioners.

Commissioner Berger stated that 26 candidates passed the written Police exam. After the oral interviews, with one candidate dropping out, 18 candidates were eligible for placement on the Roster. The Eligibility Roster was established on August 14, 2017 and will expire in two years on August 13, 2019.

Chief Jones indicated continuing success with the Department's Community Outreach programs such as the Bike Safety Rodeo, and the recent Golf outing.
