Take Precautions: During Winter Weather

Lindenhurst, IL – This winter, residents are advised to take necessary precautions during this period of extreme cold.

Warming Shelter

The Lindenhurst Police Department Conference room will serve as a warming shelter. Residents who need this service should call the Police Department non-emergency number at (847) 356-5400.

Village Infrastructure

Unfortunately, severe cold weather could impact our infrastructure and cause water mains to break. If you see water collecting on the street or right-of-way or water leaking out of a fire hydrant, please call the Police Department non-emergency number to report it at (847) 356-5400. Also, please drive with care as rock salt is not effective for melting ice and snow when temperatures are this extreme.

Safety Precautions

Residents are encouraged to proceed with caution during this weather event. If you must be out, consider making trips that are only necessary and that cannot wait until conditions have improved.

Please dress appropriately in winter attire and do not stay outside for any period of time. Keep pets safe and bring animals inside. Stock your vehicle with extra winter attire, a blanket, shovel, bottled water and other emergency essentials. Fill up your vehicle's gas tank completely and ensure you have ample washer fluid.
