### **For Pets Spayed/Neutered (proof required at the time of service)**

- 1-year rabies vaccination and Lake County tag: **\$20**
- 1-year rabies vaccination, tag, and distemper: **\$25**
- Distemper complex only: **\$10**
- Microchip: **\$15**

### **For Pets NOT Spayed/Neutered**

- 1-year rabies vaccination and Lake County tag: **\$60**
- 1-year rabies vaccination, tag, and distemper: **\$65**
- Distemper complex only: **\$10**
- Microchip: **\$15**

The 4-H dog spin club, K9 Krew, will also be offering nail trims for a \$5 donation.  
**Cash ONLY** payment is required at the time of service.

***All pets brought to the clinic should be at least four months old.  
Dogs must be leashed and cats placed in carriers.***
