

2020 MFT Resurfacing Program

Approval: Bid Award for 2020 MFT Resurfacing Program – Payne & Dolan - \$1,488,030.35

As part of our six-year plan to reverse the deterioration curve of our road network, the Village Board is pursuing an increased resurfacing program meant to address more areas of need within our community. In addition, to our usual biennial MFT program, we will be supplementing our resurfacing dollars with funds from Community Capital and the Garbage Fund. In total, we anticipated expensing about \$1.55M to address about 2.75 miles worth of roadway.

On March 11, we opened bids from two companies in response to our resurfacing scope of work. The responding companies were Payne & Dolan and Peter Baker & Sons. For the entire scope of services including alternates, Payne & Dolan presented the lowest cost, most responsible and responsive bid. After reviewing the documents, we made a recommendation to accept the full base bid plus Alternates #2 and #3. Alternate #1 included just a section of Constitution of drive we believe we can address through other means. The total cost for this work is \$1,488,030.35. This cost will allow us to maintain 5% as contingency. As a reminder, we will match \$830,000 of MFT funds with \$525,000 and \$200,000 from the Community Capital and Garbage funds, respectively.

This year our resurfacing program will include:

- Independence Boulevard from Constitution Court to US 45 (including Concord Court, Windsor Court, Hancock Court)
- Penn Boulevard from Colony Avenue to Hamilton Drive
- Adams Drive from Monroe Avenue to Penn Boulevard
- Northgate Road from Beck Road to High Point Drive
- Meadowlark Circle
- Warbler Court and Thrush Circle
