## **Election Petition Filing**

**Lindenhurst, Illinois** – The April 6, 2021 Consolidated Election will include the following Village of Lindenhurst offices:

### **Village Trustee – 3 Trustees, each for a 4-year term of office**

Courtesy Election Petition Packets are currently available at the Village of Lindenhurst, 2301 Sand Lake Road, Lindenhurst, IL. At this time, while Village Offices are closed to the public, packets may be mailed, or requested via email from [vvan@lindenhurstil.org](mailto:vvan@lindenhurstil.org) or by phone at 847-356-8252.

The **first day to file** nominating petitions at the Village of Lindenhurst is on **Monday, December 14, 2020 and will start at 8:00 am** and the **last day to file** is **Monday, December 21, 2020 and will end at 5:00 pm**.

The Village of Lindenhurst will be able to accept petitions 8:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday – Friday during the petition filing period.

On the first day to file, December 14, 2020, Village Offices will be open at 8 am, for the sole purpose of accepting petitions. Those arriving by 8 am will be provided with a “simultaneous filer” receipt, and will be placed into the lottery to determine ballot placement. After that time, petitions may be filed at the Village office during the hours listed above by an appointment made with Deputy Village Clerk, Vicki VanSlochteren, at [vvan@lindenhurstil.org](mailto:vvan@lindenhurstil.org) or 847-356-8252

The Village will remain open to accept petitions from 4-5:00 pm on the last day to file, December 21, 2020. Any petitions filed during that time will be placed in a lottery to determine ballot placement.

No petitions will be accepted after 5:00 pm on Monday, December, 21, 2020.

The Deputy Village Clerk and staff cannot provide a review of nominating papers or legal opinions regarding petition papers. Prospective candidates are strongly encouraged to consult competent legal counsel regarding qualifications to seek office, preparation of petition papers, circulator requirements, signature requirements, etc. After petition papers have been filed, pages cannot be amended or added. A receipt for filing the required Statement of Economic Interests may be added until 5 pm on the last day to file.

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
